**THIS MATTER** coming up on 02/12/2025 in Chambers for directions on the Petitioner/Applicant's Notice of Motion Application dated 28/11/2025 before the Honourable Mr. Justice Bahati Mwamuye MBS, and upon a preliminary consideration of the same **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED THAT:**

1. Pending the *inter partes* hearing and determination of the Petitioner/Applicant's Notice of Motion Application dated 28/11/2025, **a conservatory order be and is hereby issued in the nature of a mandatory order compelling the Respondents**, jointly and severally, to forthwith reinstate/restore the security detail and arrangements of the 1st Interested Party and the 2nd Interested Party in the numbers, composition, and other particulars as they existed immediately before the impugned actions of the Respondents.
2. Pending the *inter partes* hearing and determination of the Petitioner/Applicant's Notice of Motion Application dated 28/11/2025, **a conservatory order be and is hereby issued restraining the Respondents**, jointly and severally, from negatively interfering with or detrimentally varying the security detail and arrangements of the 1st Interested Party and the 2nd Interested Party in terms of the numbers, composition, and particulars as they existed immediately before the impugned actions of the Respondents.
3. The Petitioner shall serve the Respondents and the Interested Parties with the Application, the Petition, and this Court Order in both hardcopy and softcopy **immediately** and file an Affidavit of Service in that regard by close of business 05/12/2025.
4. The Respondents and the Interested Parties shall enter appearance and file and serve their respective responses to both the Application and the Petition; and they shall do so by close of business 30/12/2025.



5. The Petitioner shall have leave to file and serve a rejoinder, if need be, and it shall do so by close of business 16/01/2026.

6. Mention on 21/01/2026 to confirm compliance and to take directions on the expedited hearing and determination of the Application and/or Petition.
